Used Materials

Some Yarn and Colors Red Wine no. 030 (approx. 10gr)

Some Yarn and Colors Gold no. 089

Some Yarn and Colors White no. 001

Crochet hook 2.5 mm

Tapestry needle

Fiber fill

Stitch marker

Used abbreviations

MR = magic ring

SC = Single Crochet

Sl. St. = slip stitch

Dec. = Decrease

Inc. = Increase

BL = back loops

FL = Front Loops

CH = Chain

With Yarn and Colors Red Wine no. 030

The Christmas bauble is filled while crocheting.

1. 6sc in MR (6sc)

2. 6x (inc.) (12sc)

3. 6x (1sc, inc.) (18sc)

4. 6x (1sc, inc., 1sc) (24sc)

5. 6x (3sc, inc.) (30sc)

6. 6x (2sc, inc., 2sc) (36sc)

7. 6x (5sc, inc.) (42sc)

8. 6x (3sc, inc., 3sc) (48sc)

9. 6x (7sc, inc.) (54sc)

10.-19. 54sc

20. 6x (7sc, dec.) (48sc)

21. 6x (3sc, dec., 3sc) (42sc)

22. 6x (5sc, dec.) (36sc)

23. 6x (2sc, dec., 2sc) (30sc)

24. 6x (3sc, dec.) (24sc)

25. 6x (1sc, dec., 1sc) (18sc)

26. 6x (1sc, dec.) (12sc)

Continue with Gold

27. in BL 12sc

28.-30. 12sc

31. in BL 6x (dec.) (6sc)

Fasten off, fill up, close the ring and weave in the ends.



Join with Gold in the FL of round 31 and ch 8, 1sl.st. in the FL on the other side of round 31. Fasten off and weave in the end. This way you have a loop to hang the Christmas bauble.

Join with Gold in the FL of round 27 and crochet 12sc. Fasten off and weave in the end.

Embroider white snowflakes on the Christmas bauble. I also used Gold over the white thread for some Christmas Glam.
